This workshop will work with each handler to a better understanding of the connection between dog and handler through correct mapping skills and leash usage.

The Workshop will focus on mapping and proper line handling skills for a better partnership with your dog. Participants will learn how to make a map so it can be found afterwards. There will be discussion on equipment usage and things that are OK to do in the field as well as things that will get you the whistle!
